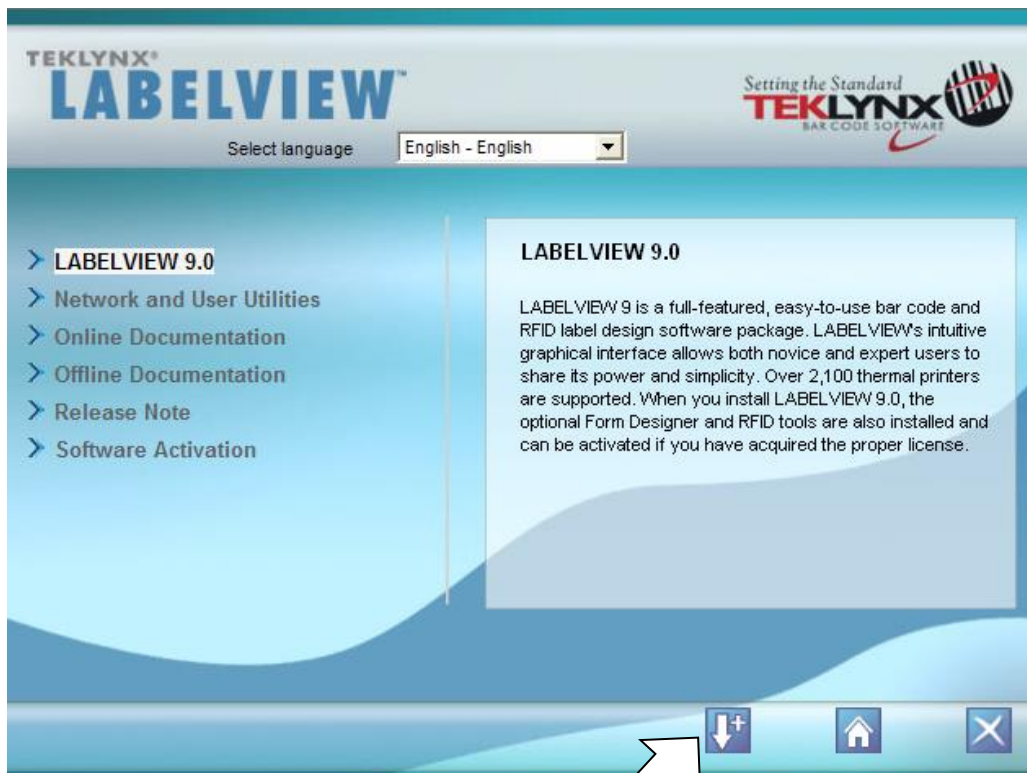

Insert CD into CD ROM DRIVE, the window shown below will come into view. Insert the USB License Key into a USB Port, then press the Down Arrow Key.

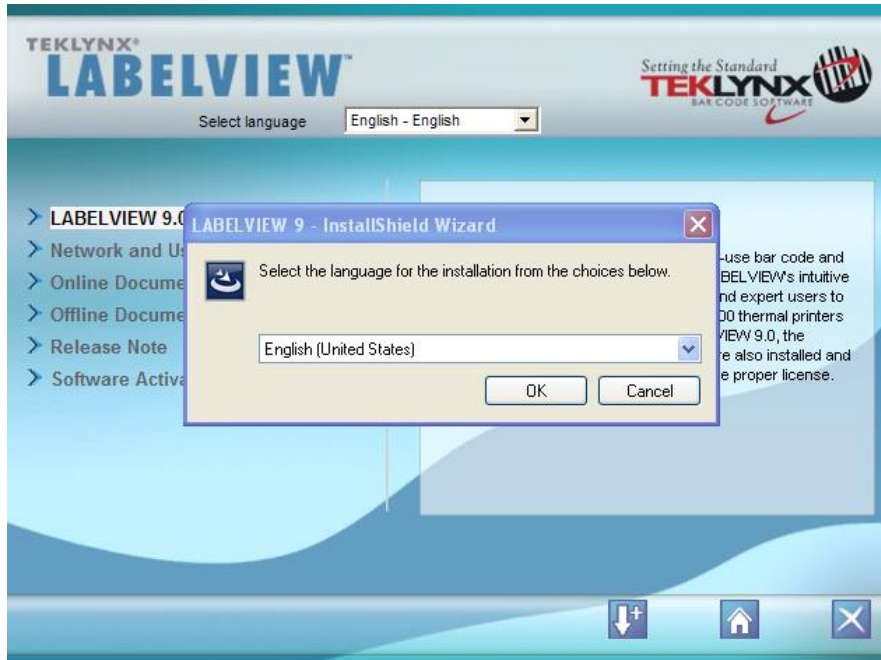

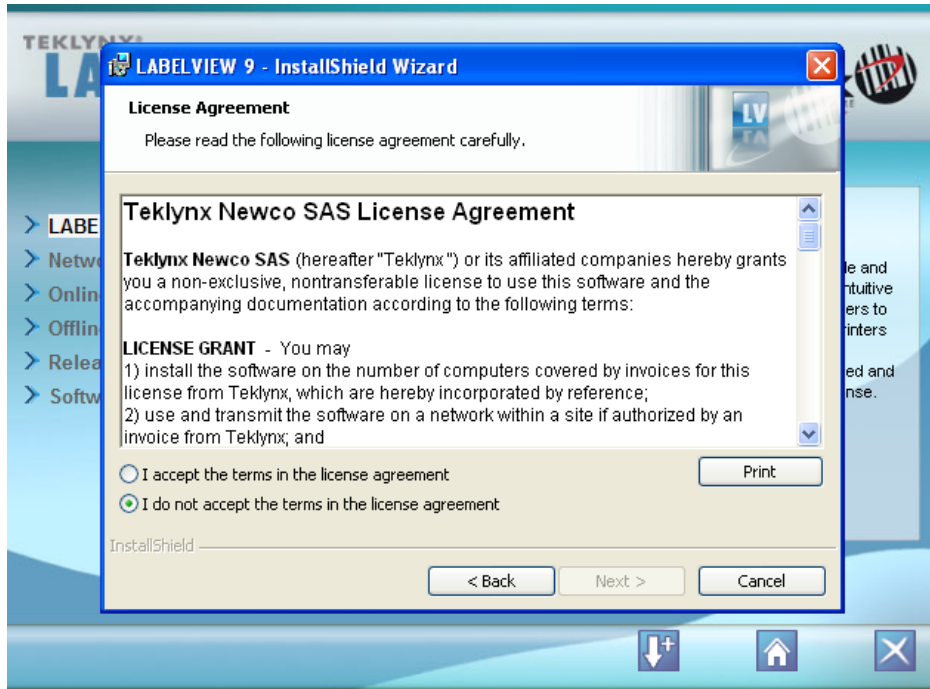




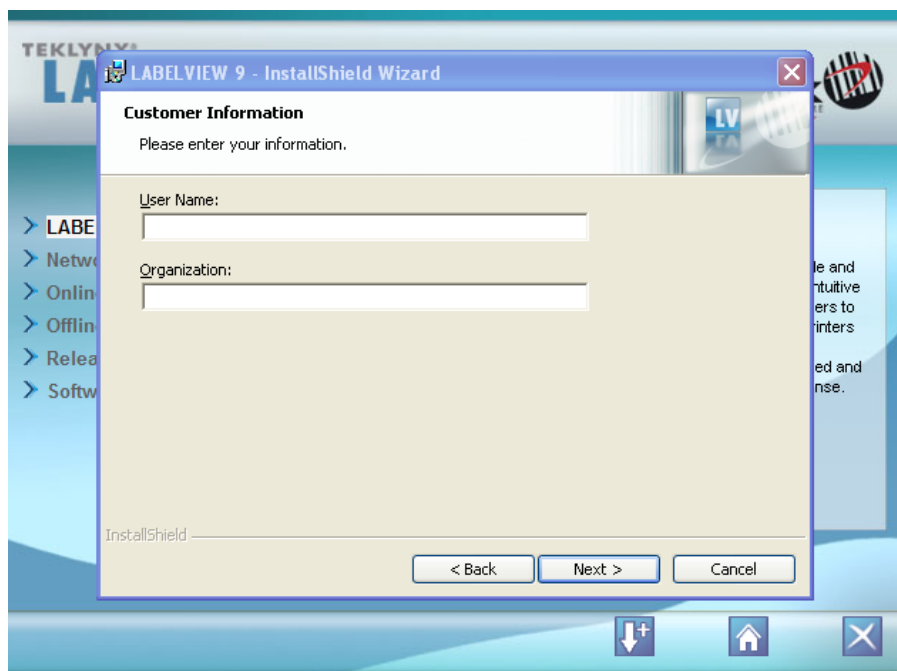

Type in your name (not required), Click “Next”.

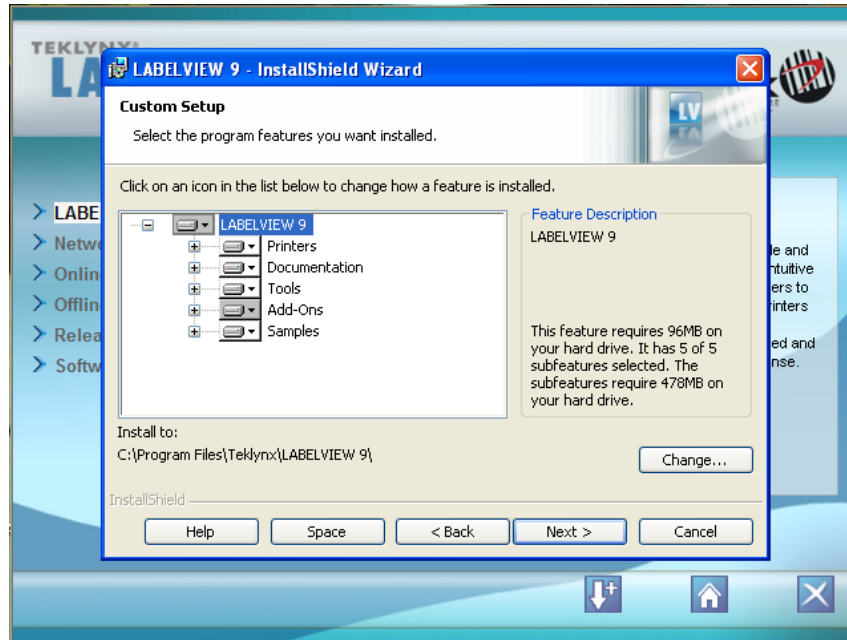




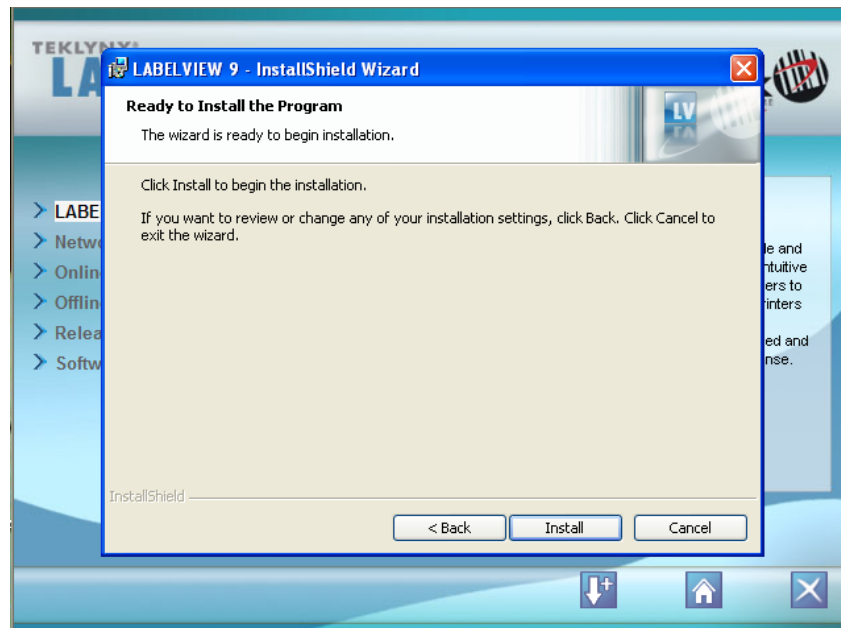

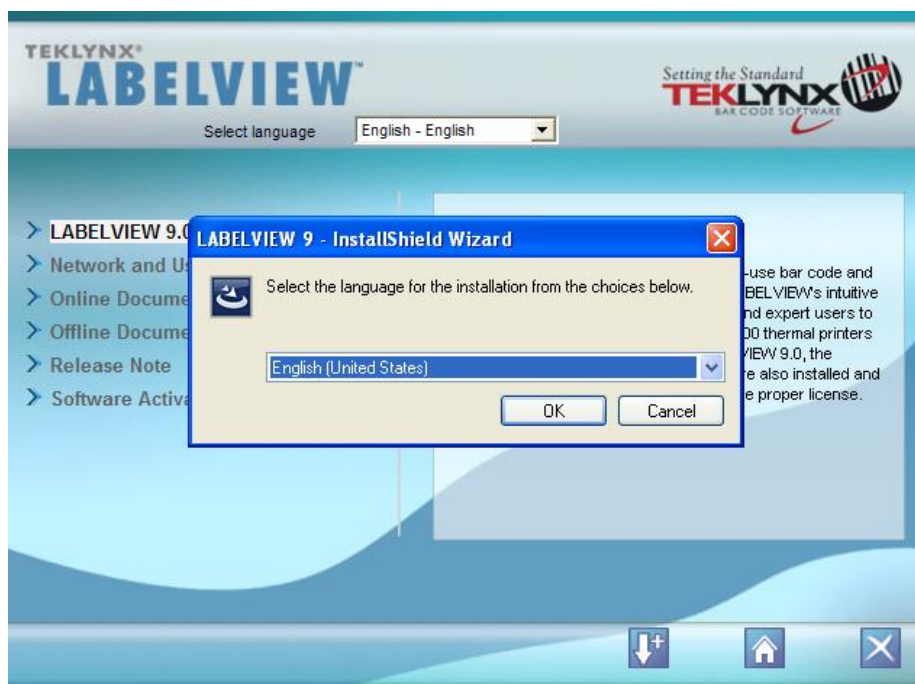

This Window will now be shown. Select the desired language, then press “OK”.





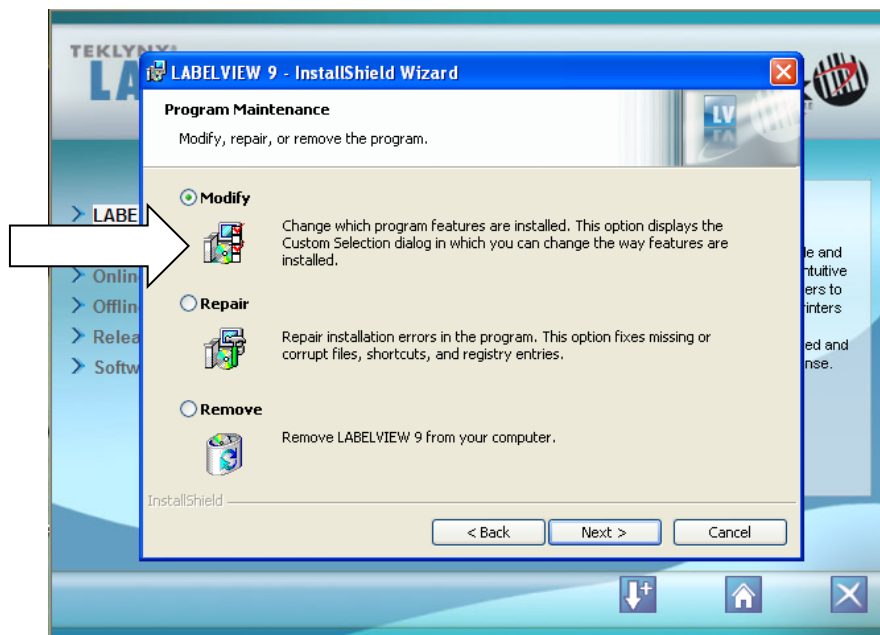

Select "Modify"; Click "Next"

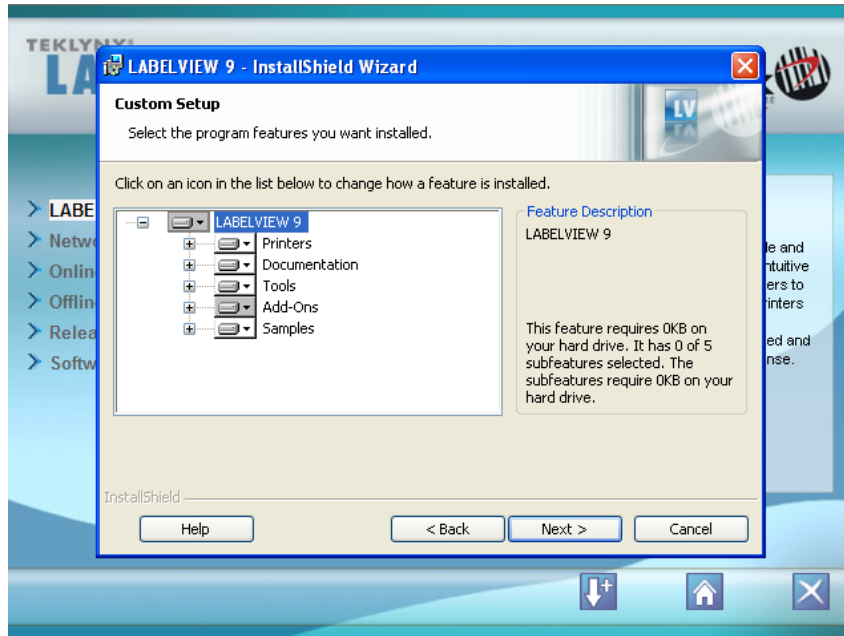




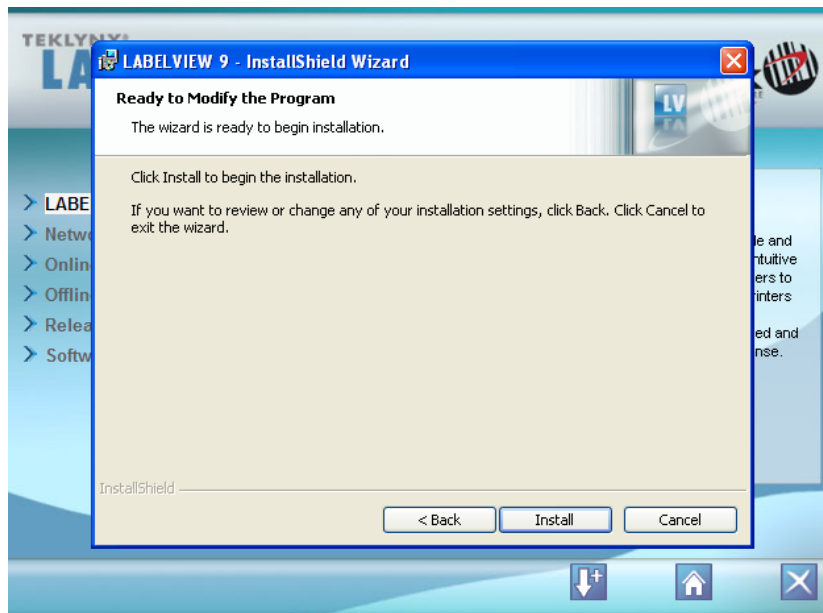

Click “Add Printer”

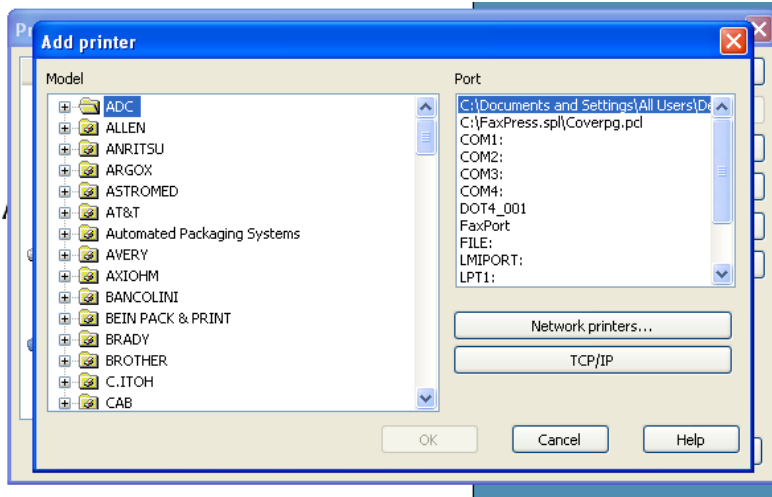




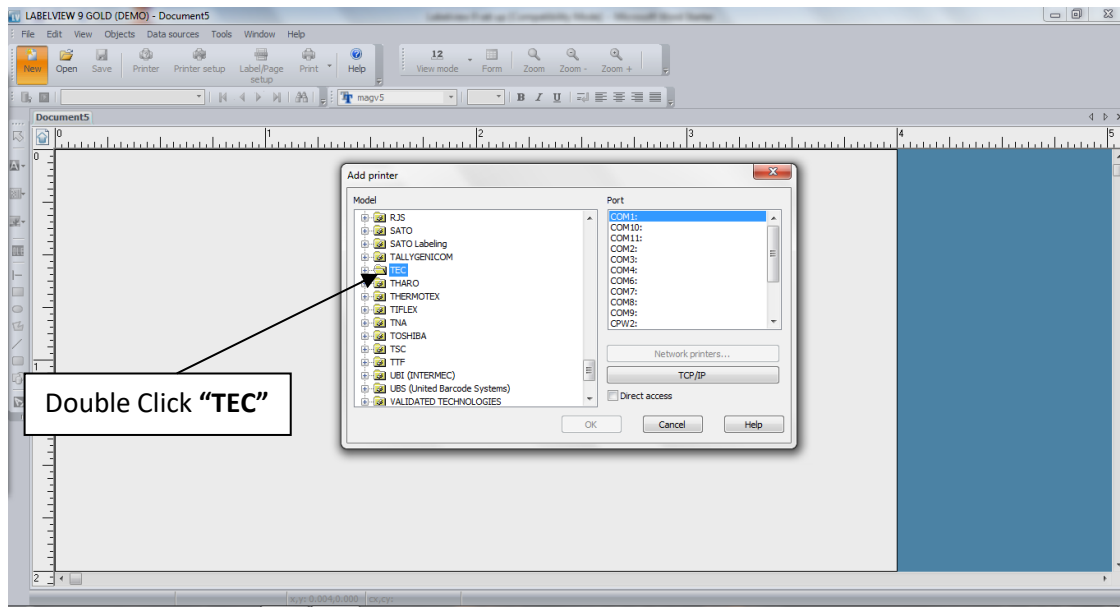

“Add Printer” window opens.



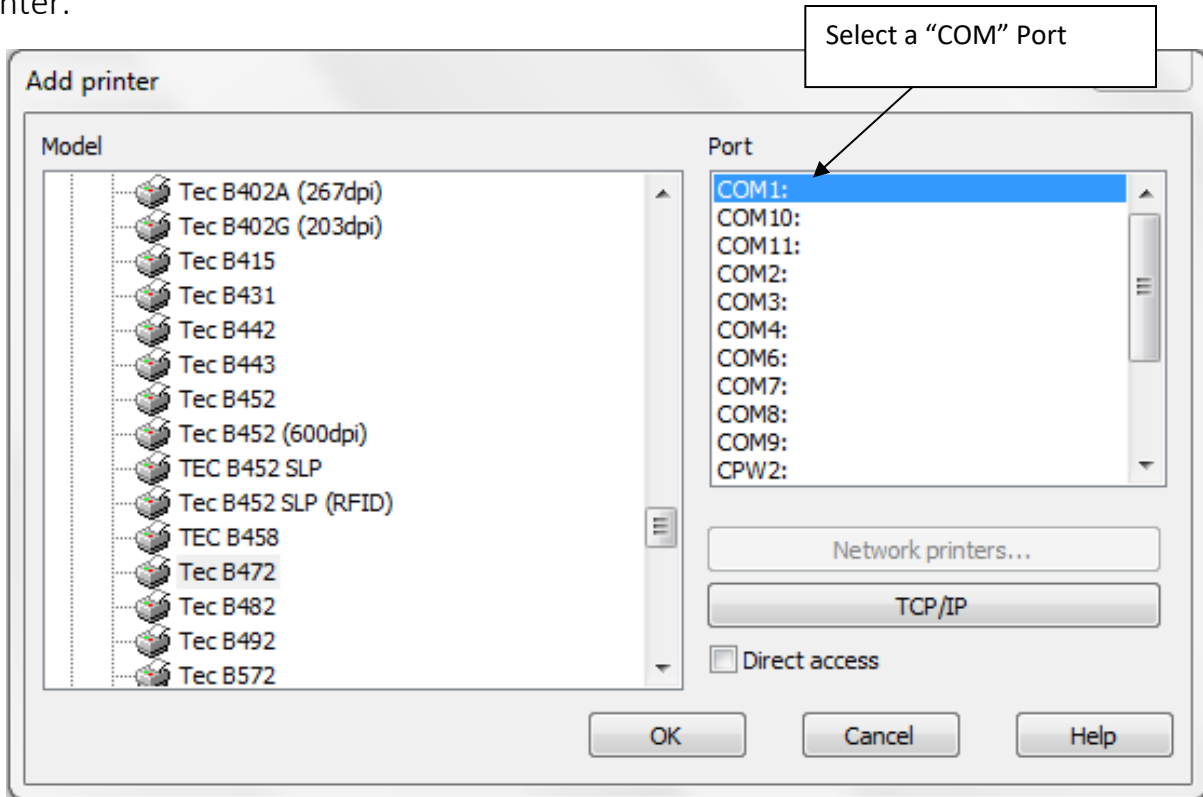
Scroll Down and select “TEC” then double-click.

With the TEC Folder open select “Tec B472” or “Tec B572”, depending on your printer.



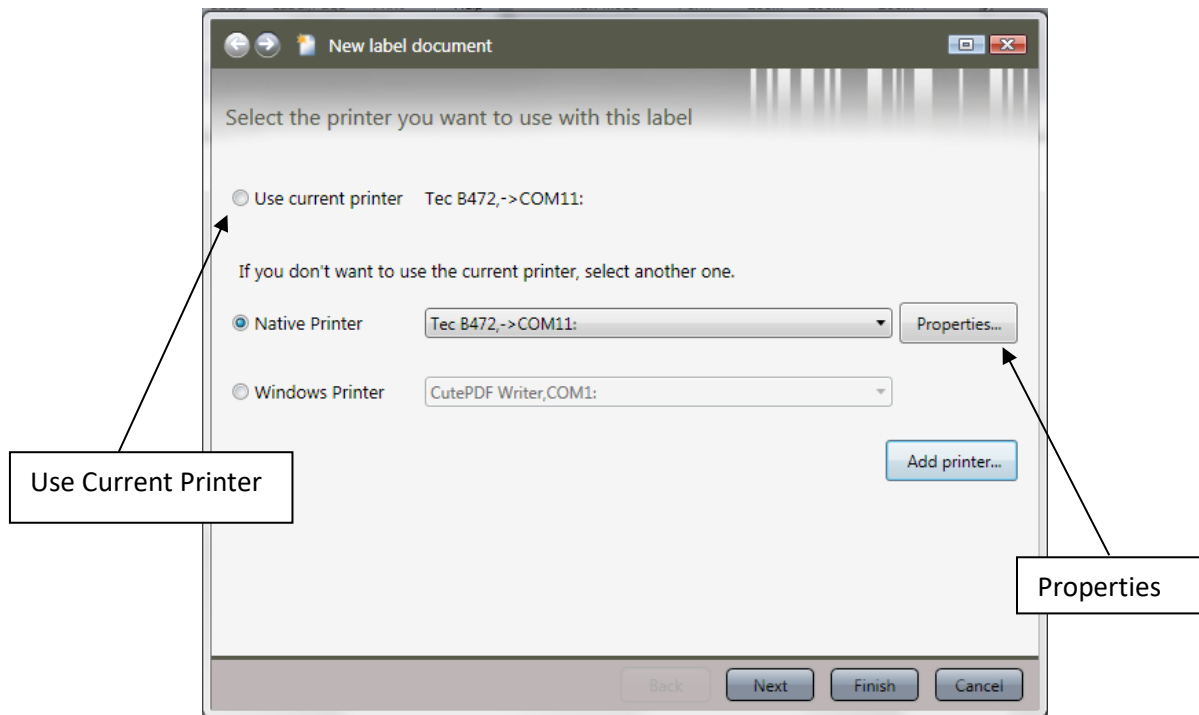
Port Setting: Select one of the “COM” Ports.

After Clicking “OK”, the “New Label Document” window will appear.

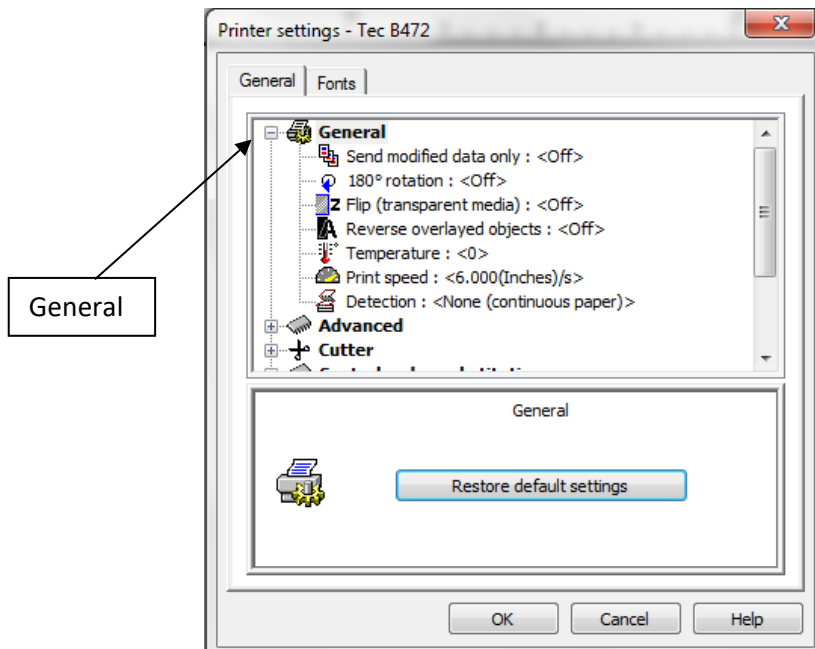

Click on **"Use Current Printer"** which will be **"Tec B472"** or **"Tec B572"** on Port____. This will be highlighted in blue.

Now **"Click on PROPERTIES"**. This window will appear.

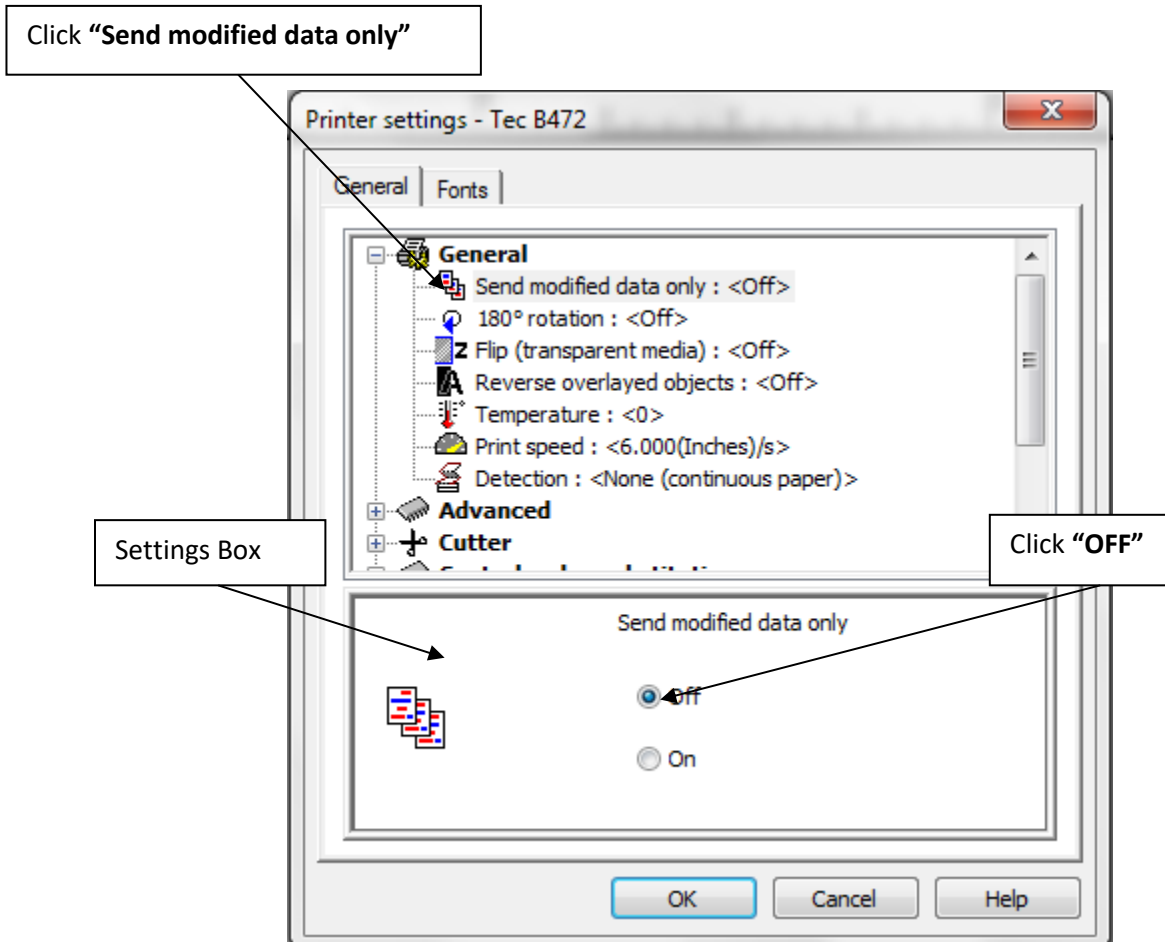

The following are steps to enter settings in “General”:



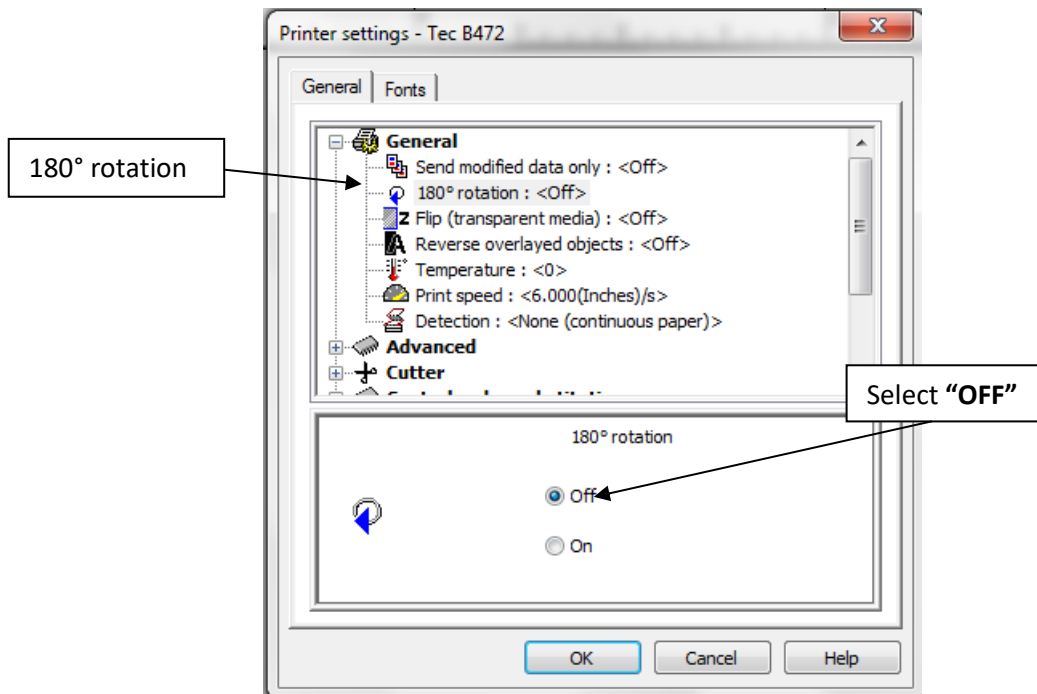
On the drop-down menu click “Send modified data only”.

Notice the Settings Box, it now has “ON” and “OFF” buttons; select “OFF”.

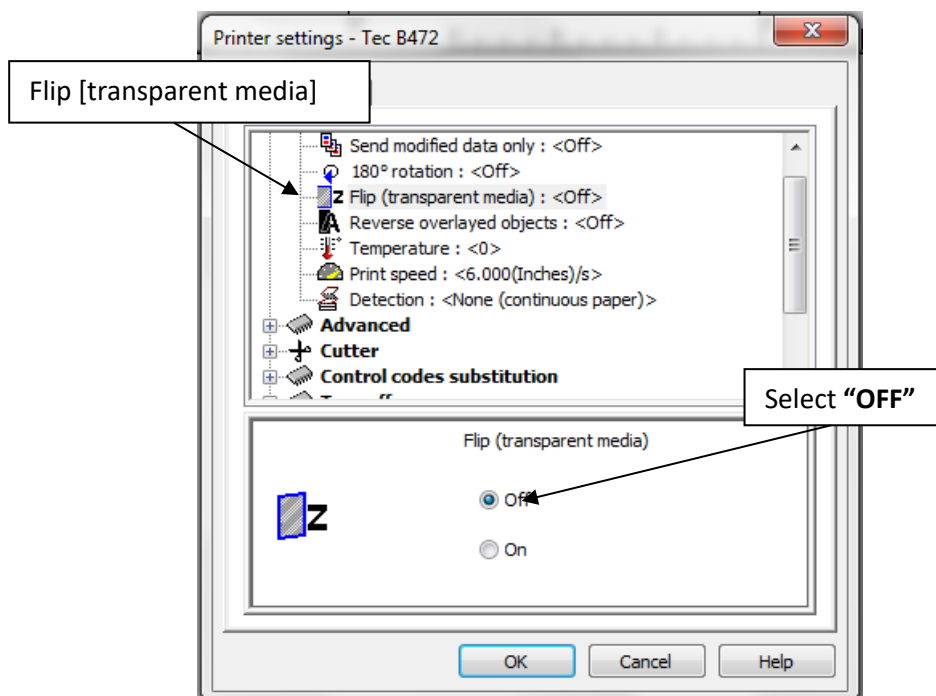

Click on "180 rotation": Turn to "OFF".

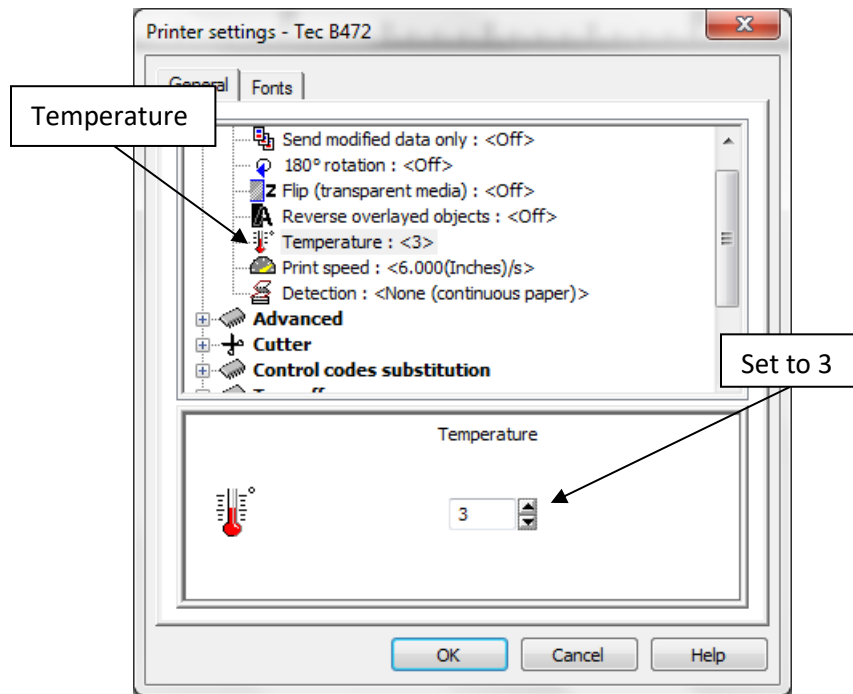


Select "Flip [(transparent media)]": Turn to "OFF".

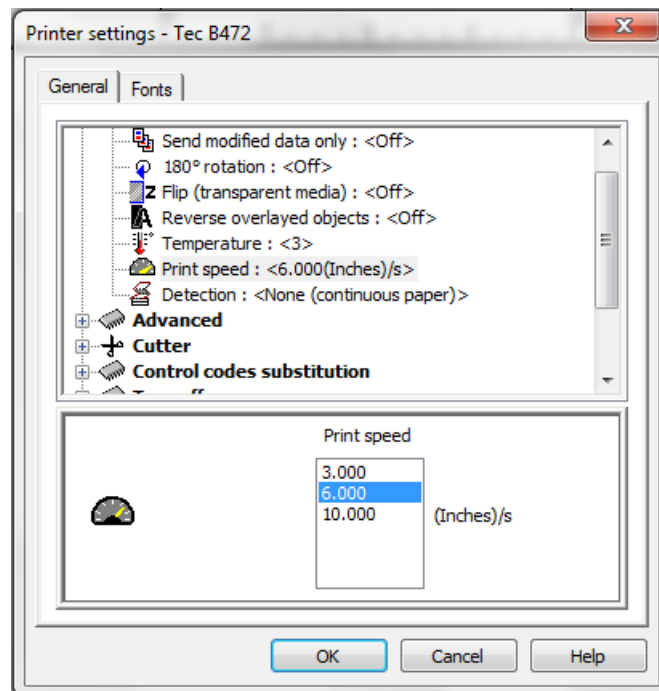

Click “Temperature” then set to 3.

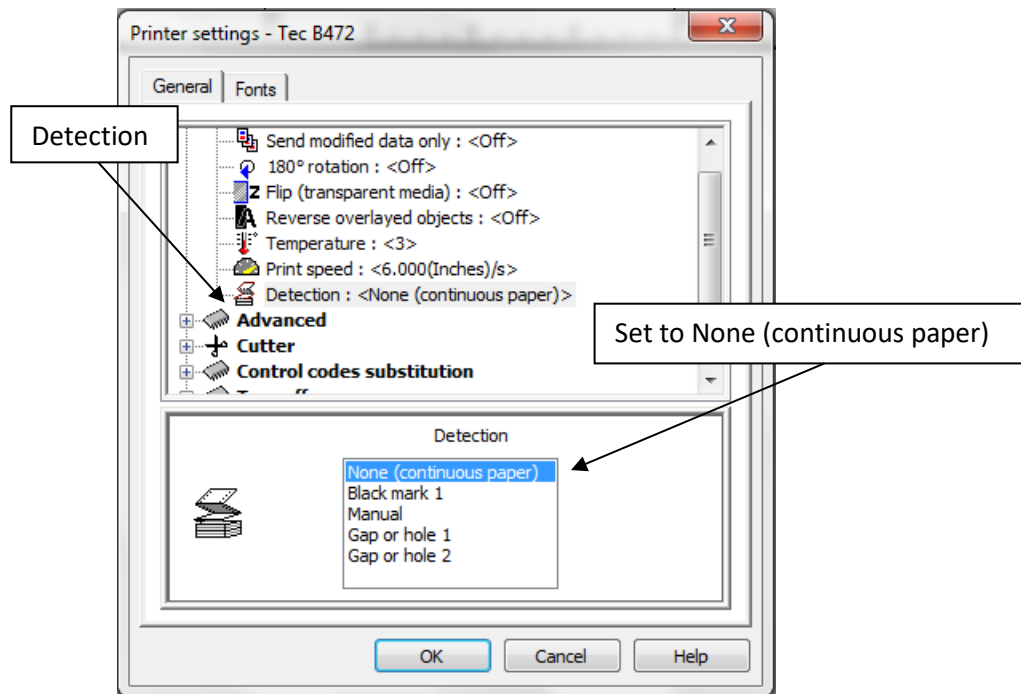


Click “Print speed” and set to 6.000

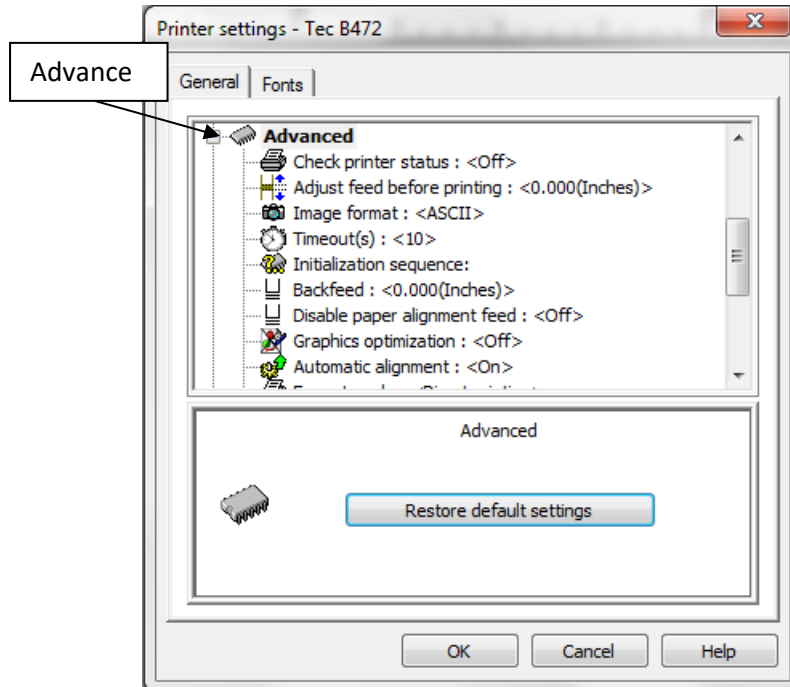

Click “Detection” and set to “continuous paper”

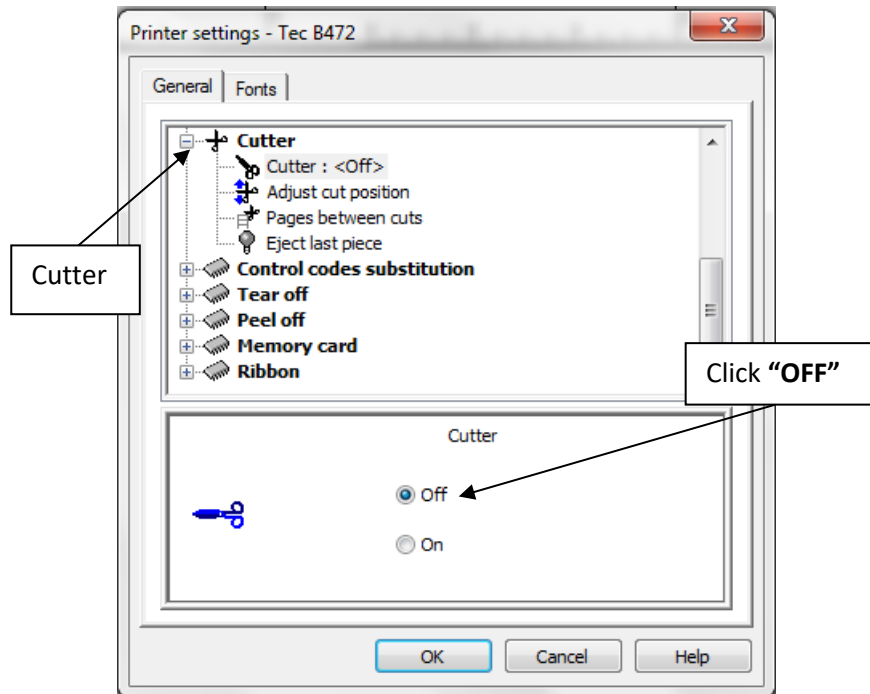


Click “Advanced” and make sure all settings are the same as above. If not, correct them using the same procedure in “General”.

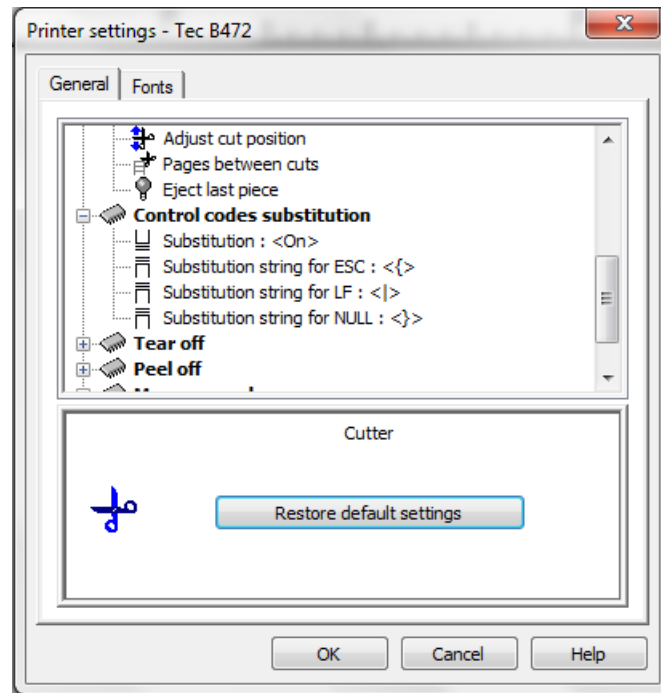

Click on **“Cutter”**, select **“Cutter”**, click **“OFF”**.

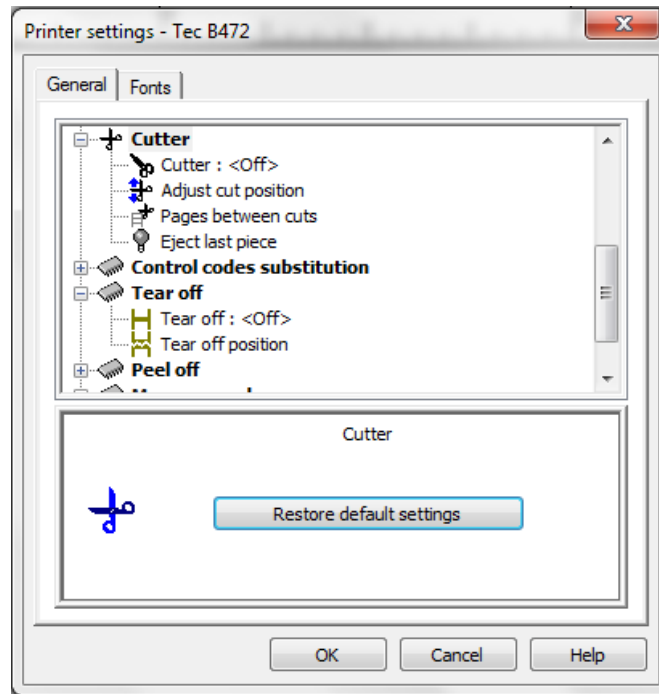


Click **“Control codes substitution”** and make sure all settings are same as above. If not, use the same procedure as in **“General”**.

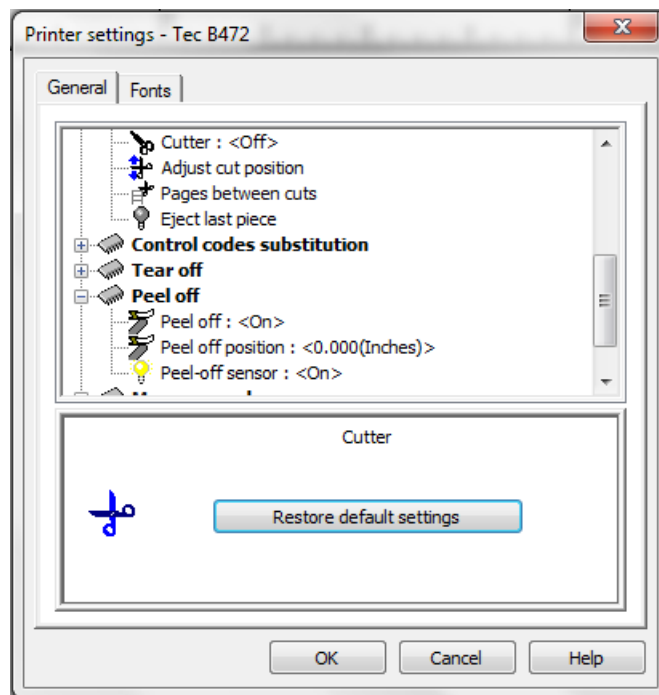

Tear off should be "OFF".

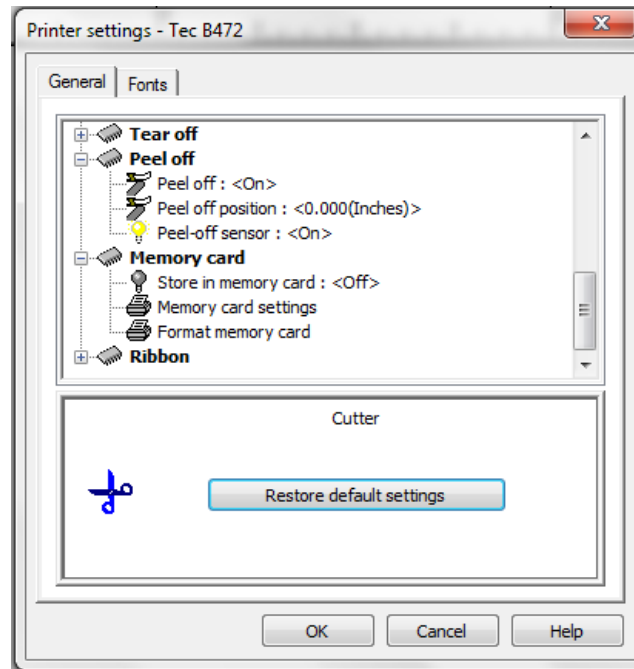


Peel off: <ON>; Peel off position: <0.000(inches)>; Peel off sensor: <ON>

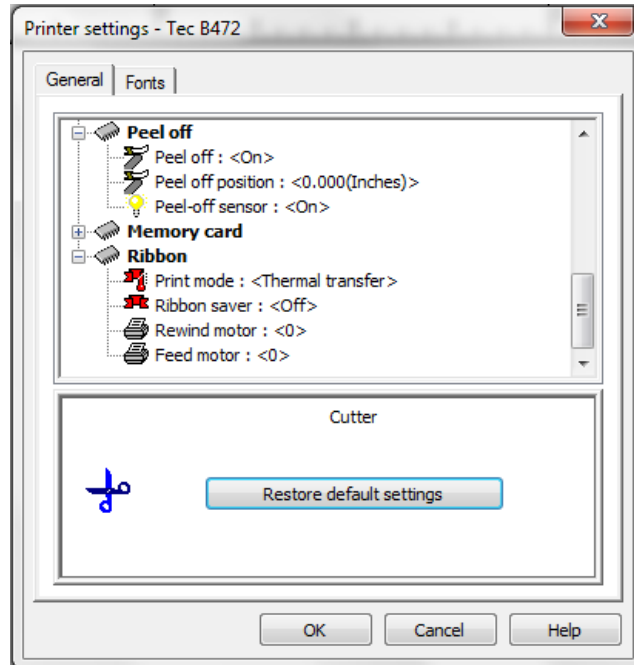

Memory card, Store in memory card: <OFF>

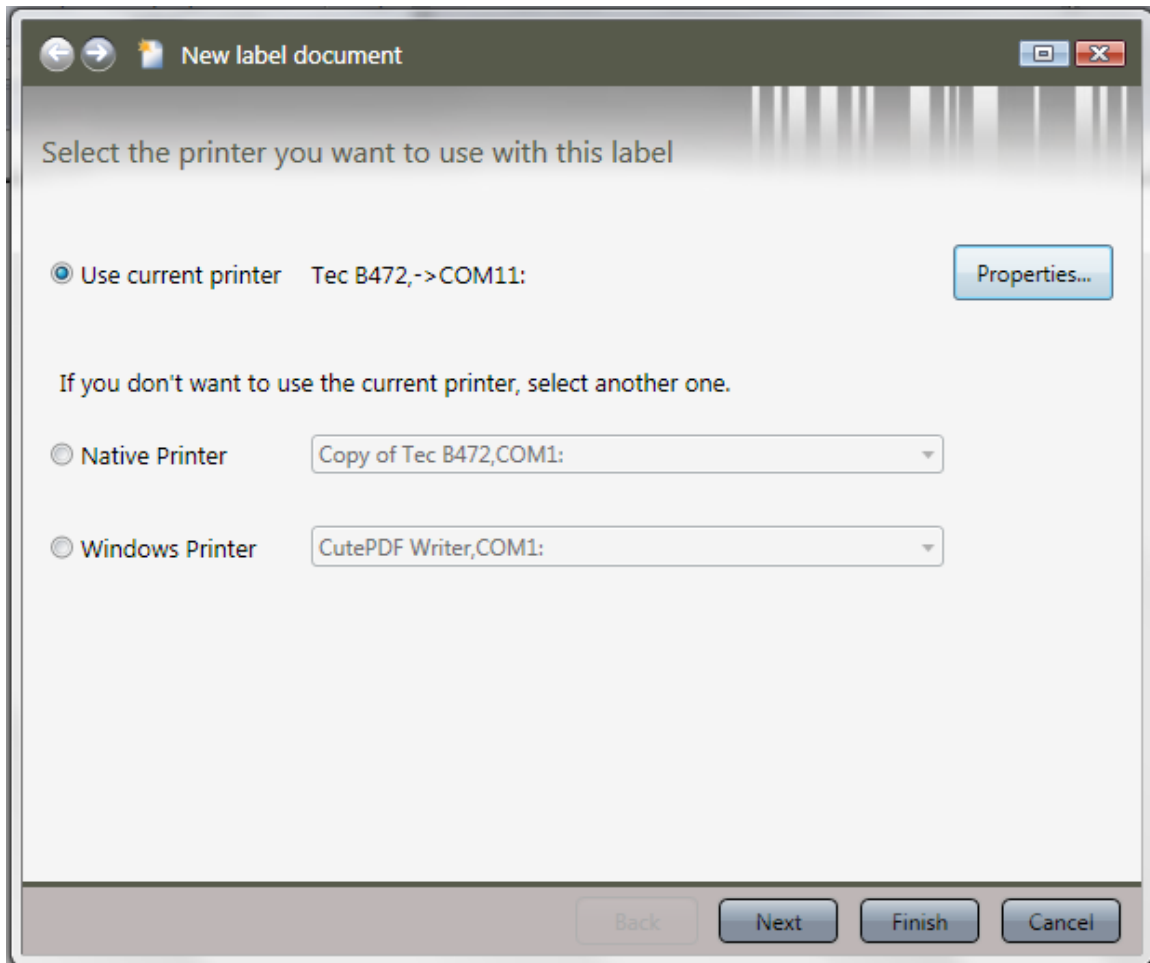


Ribbon: Print mode: <Thermal transfer>; Ribbon saver: <OFF>; Rewind motor: <0>;

Press "OK"



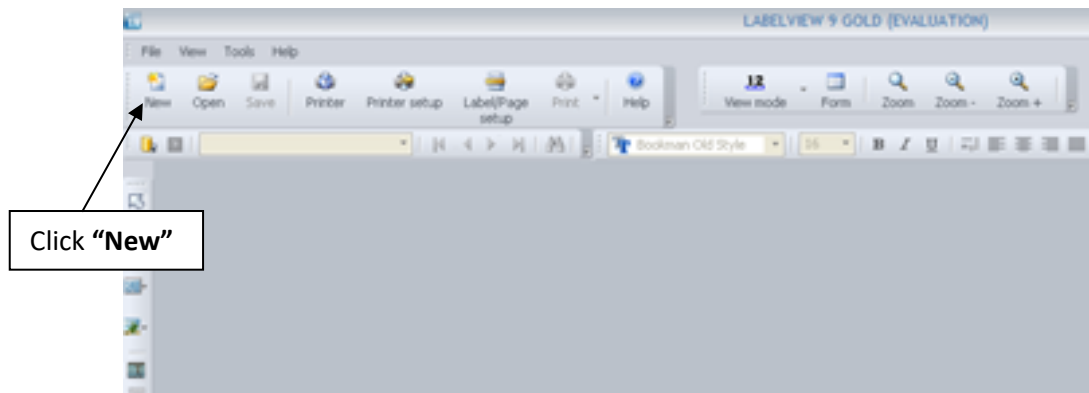

Create Your Label:

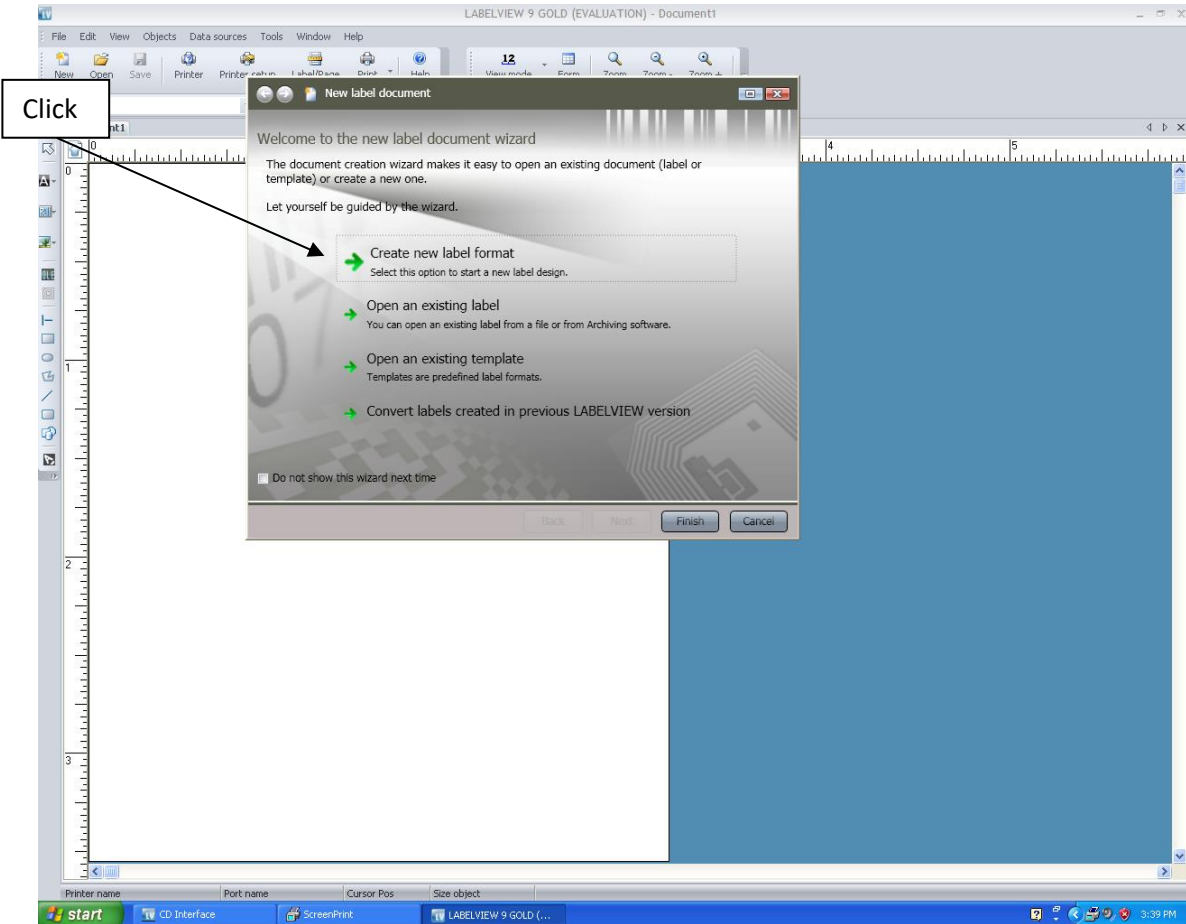


Click "New" icon.

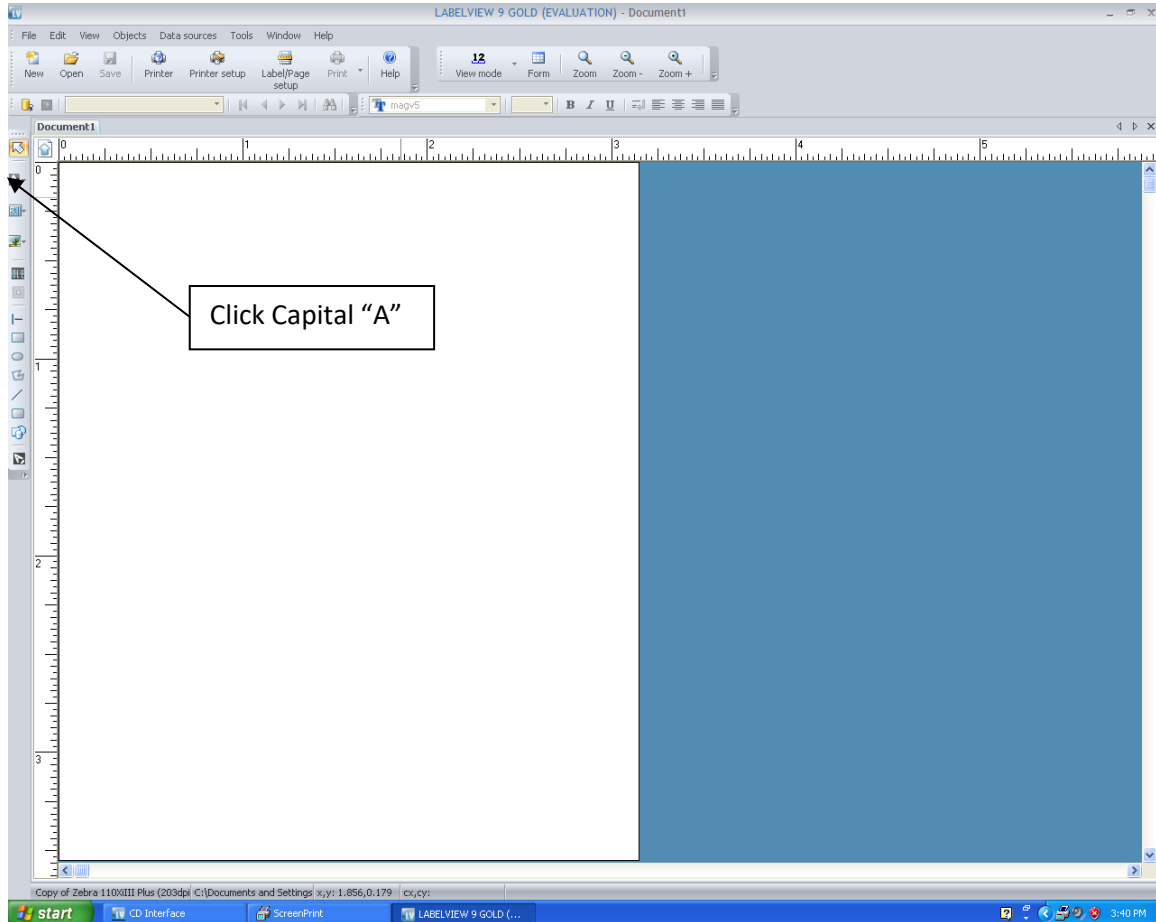


Click “Create New Label Format”.

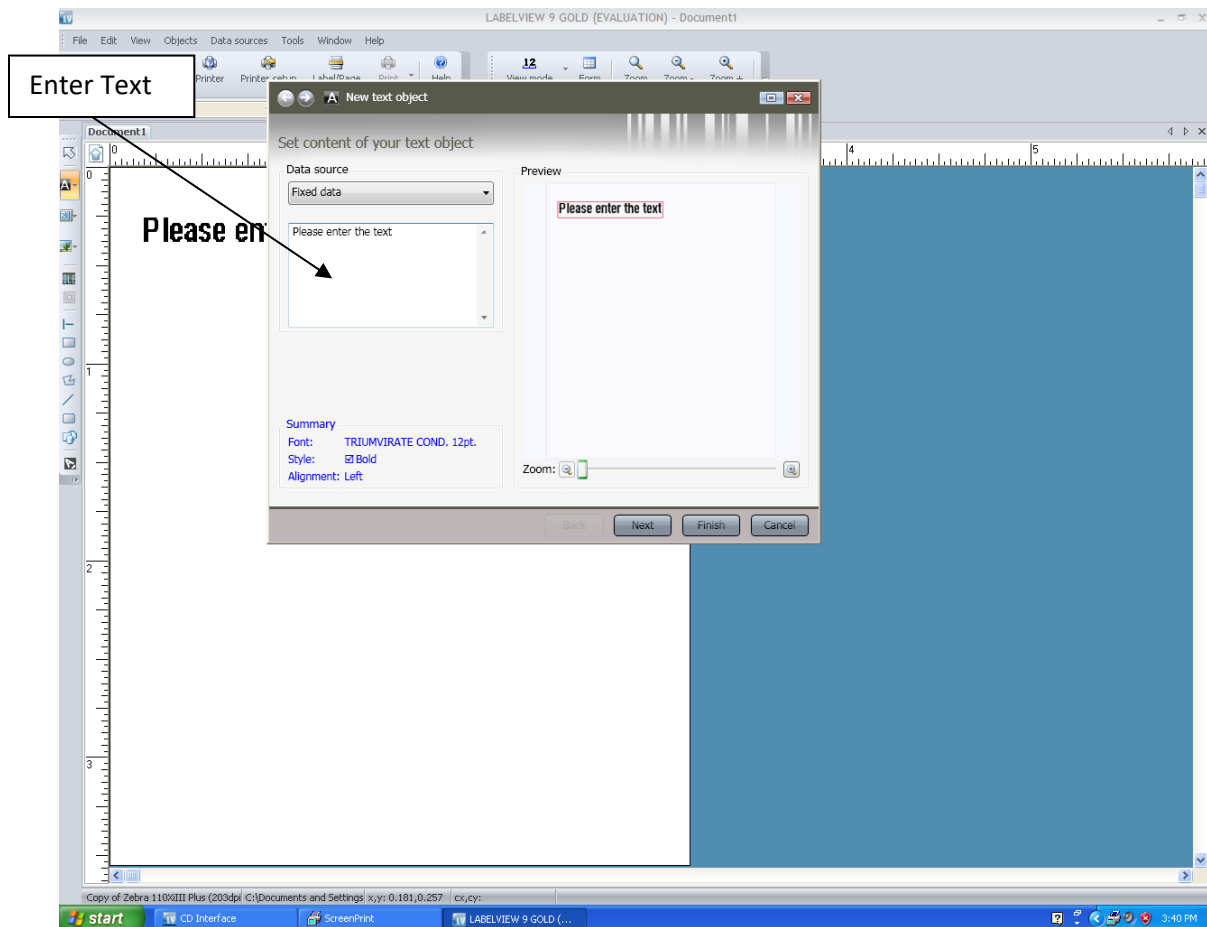


Click the capital “A” Add Text icon.

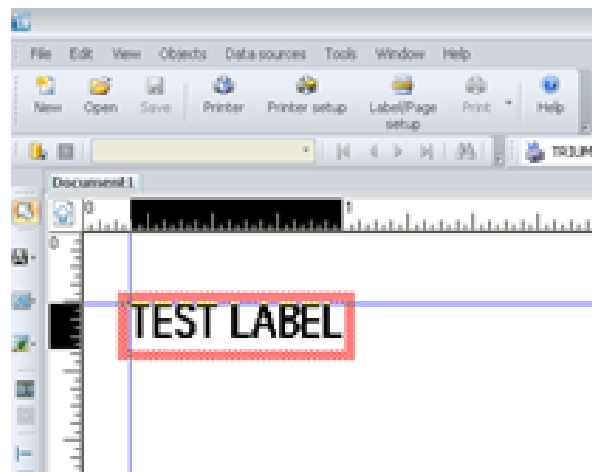


How To

Enter the Label information or the word **“TEST”** into Text Field.
Click **“Next”**.

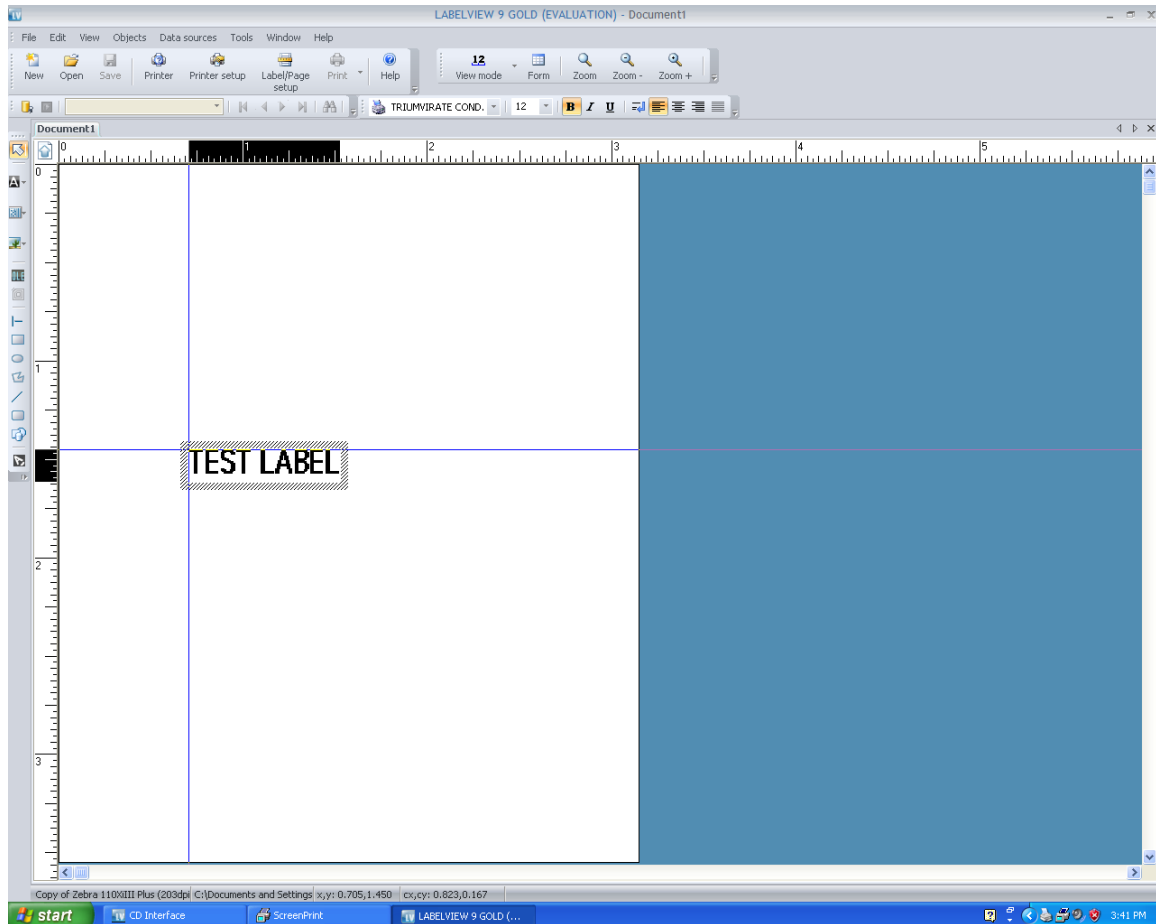


The TEXT can be moved by dragging it to the desired position.

Service Documents from APPI

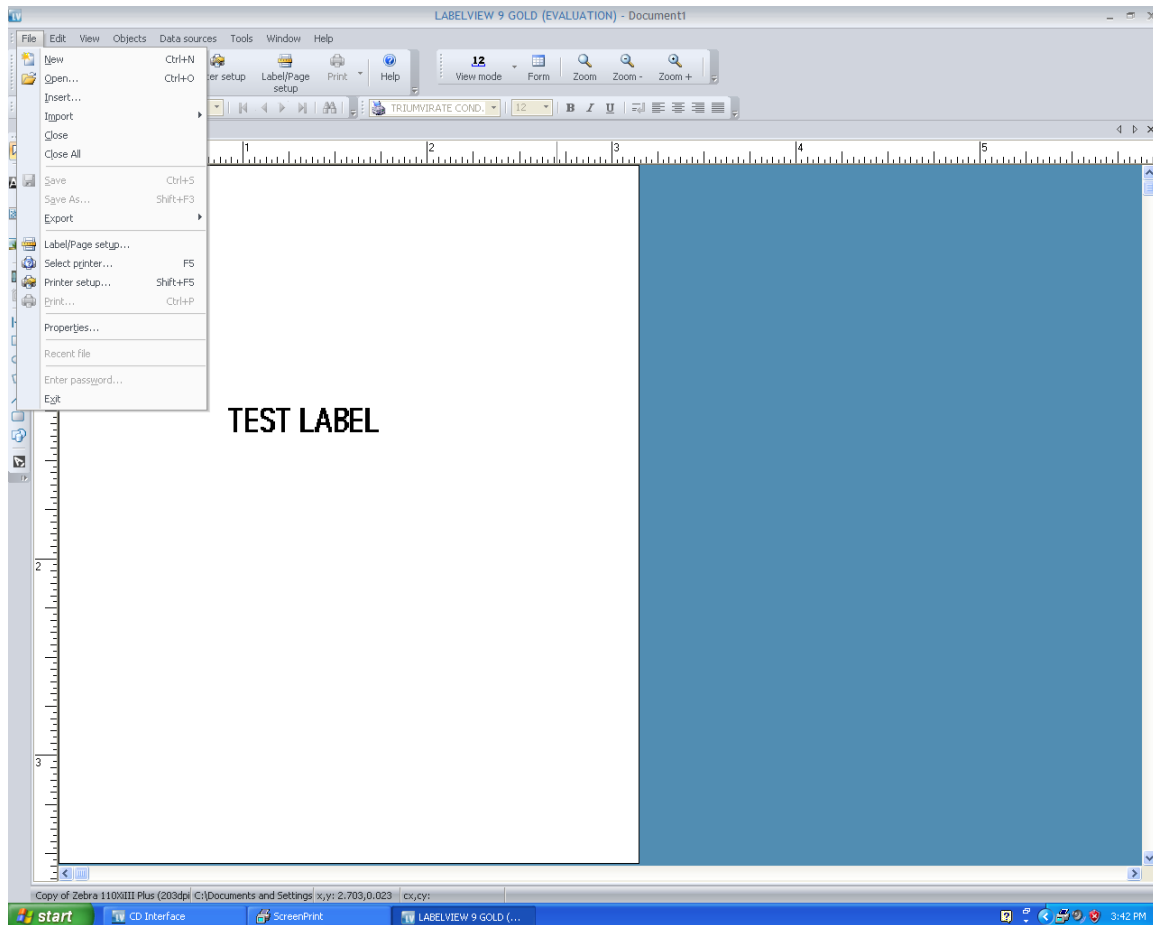


Click on the blank area of the label to lock its position.

Click on **“File”**, click **“Save As”** test label.
