



**Document Title: Replace PLC Battery** 


**Product(s): T-300/T-375** 

**Procedure:** 

If your Bagger has a Main Power Lockout Switch, turn it counter-clockwise to OFF.




Remove the two Button Head Screws holding the **Side Panel** on and remove **Side Panel**.






Note: If you don't have a Lock Out LEAVE POWER ON.

If you have a **Lockout Key** turn it to power **ON**. If you don't have a **Lockout Key**, use a screwdriver.




Important: Keep Power On while changing Battery, or you may lose the program in the PLC.




Close Up View



Locate the two **Blue Tabs** on the bottom of the **PLC**. With a small screwdriver, carefully pull them down to unlock the **PLC** and **Analog Card** from the DIN Rail.



Carefully pull the bottom out first, and lift PLC out.






Insert a small screwdriver into the slot of Battery Compartment and carefully open it.











Unplug the Connector and plug in the new battery, making sure the **Red Wire** is on the same side as the old connector.






Place Battery in Battery Compartment







Replace Battery Cover



Place PLC on top of DIN rail first, then push bottom in.








Gently push both **Blue Tabs** up to lock **PLC** to DIN Rail.



Turn the **Lock Out** to the **OFF** position


